

# Ischemic Optic Neuropathy Clinical Study: QRK207

## STILL RECRUITING

- ◆ Did you wake up with a sudden loss of vision in one eye?
    - ◆ Have you been told you had a "stroke" of your optic nerve?
- If the answer is yes, you may be eligible to participate in a clinical research study to help improve vision.



### To qualify, you must:

- be 50 to 80 years old
- have experienced sudden vision loss in the last 14 days

There is currently no approved treatment for ischemic optic neuropathy.

### Study info:

- All participants will be assigned to receive intravitreal injection(s) of the experimental drug QPI-1007 and/or sham procedure to one eye over a four-month treatment period
- There are eight study visits total; the entire duration of the study is 12 months
- Eye exams will be conducted at each visit
- Visits generally take approximately 2-4 hours to complete
- All study related costs are covered; Reasonable patient travel costs may be reimbursed.
